## Project Recipe:

	<p>1. Dimensions:</p> <p>Night of Navy: 4-1/4" X 11", score at 2", 5-1/4", 6-1/2", and 7-3/4", you will also need a scrap for the ornament</p> <p>Very Vanilla: 3" X 4"</p> <p>DSP: 3" X 4" and 1-3/4" X 4"</p> <p>Gold Foil Scrap for the words</p>
	<p>2. To create the inside, fold up on the 6-1/2" score line and secure around the bottom edges and sides with tear tape or another strong adhesive. Be sure not to seal through the middle.</p>



3. To create the slit for the card, punch with the classic label punch in the middle, then enlarge the opening by moving it side to side and punching until you get an opening that is wide enough for the card. You want the card to fit snugly, so don't punch it too wide.

4. Stamp your vanilla insert as desired and adhere to the inside flap of the card.



5. Round the edges of the front flap as well as the 1-3/4" X 4" piece of DSP. Adhere this DSP to the front flap.



6. Stamp the ornament image in versamark and pour your embossing power over top, removing the excess. Heat with your heat tool until shiny. Adhere to the flap.



7. Cut out your greeting and add to the flap.

8. Add your bottom dsp and your holder is finished. You may choose to use velcro for a closure, or thin magnets, whatever you choose, someone is sure to love getting this!
